- Introduction to LALS

- Pre-1900 (choose 1 course from the following)
 - ANTH 243, 240 or 268
 - HIST 263
- Electives
 - A minimum of four (4) courses in at least three different departments.
- Language competency
 - One year of college-level study – or the equivalent – in either Spanish or Portuguese.
- 300 level seminar
 - This can be any LALS course or any of the 300-level cross listed courses on the list of [approved courses](#).
- LALS Senior Seminar
 - This course changes at the discretion of the Program Director and seminar instructor.
