Number of units required for the major: 11 units
Major requirements:

- Introduction to LALS
- LALS 105 - usually taught in the Spring term.
- Methods course (choose 1 course from the following options):
- ANTH 245, 250, or 255
- HISP 216
- SOCI 254
- POLI 207 or 273
- Language competency in Spanish or Portuguese through the third year
- Requirement can be fulfilled with HISP 216, PORT 210, or PORT 310
- One unit beyond this level is strongly recommended.
- Pre-1900 (choose 1 course from the following)
- ANTH 243, 240 or 268
- HIST 263
- Latinx Studies (choose 1 course from the following)
- EDUC 270
- ENGL 230
- GEOG 246
- SOCI 253
- 300 level seminar
- This can be any LALS course or any of the 300-level cross listed courses on the list of approved courses
- LALS Senior Seminar
- This course changes at the discretion of the Program Director and seminar instructor.
- 1 unit of intensive work
- Can be fulfilled at the 200 level with CEL or INDP work (LALS 290 or 298)
- Can be fulfilled at the 300 level with senior thesis (LALS 300, 301, 302), or senior project (LALS 303, 304, 305), or senior INDP work (LALS 399)

Additional notes:

- Only two courses at the 100-level can count towards the major.
- A maximum of 4 language units in HISP or PORT can be counted toward the major.
- For students with a double major, a maximum of 2 units can be counted toward LALS and the other major.
- Senior work is optional. Students may elect to pursue a senior project or a senior thesis under the supervision of a LALS faculty member.
- Three units at the 300-level are highly recommended: Senior seminar plus two other seminars OR senior seminar, a second seminar, and senior thesis/project.
- A maximum of 2 units of relevant coursework taken during study abroad can count toward the major. This must be approved by the Program Director.
